



2008 Cookie Cupboard Details

Cookie Cupboards are volunteers throughout the service area who keep an extra supply of cookies and are available for troops to get cookies for additional sales and booth sales, after the initial troop cookie order. Cupboards supplement initial order taking and are not intended as a substitute to fill initial troop cookie orders.

- Cupboards will be open on Friday, February 22 and Saturday, February 23 for FULL CASES ONLY.
- Cupboards officially open on Monday, February 25. The last open day for cupboards is Tuesday, March 10.
- To use a cupboard, you must complete a Cupboard Authorization Form. This form must be completed and turned into the Resource Center by Friday, February 1. It can be found at the back of this sale guide. Only authorized people can take cookies from the cupboards.
- Please note on the list of Cookie Cupboards if open hours are established or appointments are requested. Please respect cupboard hours.
- Please leave little helpers (children) at home when going to a cupboard.
- Attend to personal needs before going to cupboards. Please do not ask to use the telephone or restrooms.
- Only cookies taken from the cupboard may be exchanged or returned within the cupboard.
- Booth sale cookies can be checked out 1 day prior to the booth sale.
- Unsold booth sale cookies MUST be returned to the same cupboard the day after the booth sale in order to receive troop credit.
- Each time you visit a cupboard, a receipt will be given. Check receipt for accuracy before you sign, as your signature indicates your troop's responsibility for payment.
- Payment for cookies from a cupboard must be included along with your payment for your initial cookie order. Troop Cookie Managers/Troop Leaders will note this on final paperwork, but cupboards will also turn troop cupboard cookie numbers into the Resource Center.
