

## EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In the event of a serious accident, emergency, or fatality, the PERSON IN CHARGE should:

1. Give priority to caring for the injured person(s).
2. Call a doctor, ambulance, police or clergy as necessary.
3. Contact a Council representative. SEE BACK FOR NUMBERS.
4. In the event of a fatality, notify police. Retain a responsible person at the scene. Make sure victim or surroundings are not disturbed.
5. Refer all newspaper, radio or TV inquiries to the Council contact person. SEE BACK FOR NUMBERS. Do not comment to the media! Do not discuss the incident, place blame, or accept liability.
