GIRL SCOUTS – NON HOMESTEAD COUNCIL REGISTRATION FORM

- 1. Tentative reservations will be taken over the phone and held for two weeks. This registration is due 10weeks before your registered date. Visa & MasterCard accepted.
2. Fees apply to all participants, youth and adults, Reservation Fees and Signed paperwork MUST be received in the CATRON office within the two- week tentative period or the reservation will be removed from the calendar.
3. RESERVATION FEES ARE NON REFUNDABLE AND DO NOT APPLY TO THE USAGE FEES. REMAINING USE FEES MUST BE PAID IN FULL FOUR (4) WEEKS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL DATE.
4. UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED, THE PROGRAM CENTER WILL BE RESERVED FOR YOU. To reserve CATRON for day or overnight use, the CATRON registration procedures apply.
5. There is a minimum of 10 participants. The maximum for Confidence/ Low is 30. The maximum number for Confidence/ Low/ High is 24. High Elements only is not an option.
6. Brownies may participate on Confidence and Low Elements only. Daises may not be on The Challenge Course. Juniors must be 10 years old, currently in or have completed fourth grade to participate on the High elements.
7. No Come-Alongs-youth or adult may join a group on The Challenge Course.

RULES and REGULATIONS FOR USE OF CATRON and THE CHALLENGE COURSE:

1. All rules and procedures established by Girl Scouts –Homestead Council for use at Catron must be adhered to by all groups.
2. Groups will not be permitted on The Challenge Course unless they are participating under the guidance of a Girl Scouts – Homestead Council trained facilitator. Only equipment provided by CATRON-Camp and Retreat Center may be used on The Challenge Course.
3. A minimum of 10 participants is required for a Challenge opportunity. The maximum for the Highs is 24 and the Maximum for the Lows is 30. The Highs only is not an option.
4. Youth 6 to 9 years of age may participate on the Confidence and Low elements only. Youth who are currently in or have completed fourth grade or are 10 years old and above may participate on the Confidence, Low and High Elements.
5. Youth younger than 6 years of age may not participate on The Challenge Course.
6. No Come-Alongs (Youth or Adult) are allowed with the group while on The Challenge Course.
7. The Challenge Course will only be cancelled for the following weather: Thunder, lighting, ice, excessive rain or snow.
8. Participants should dress for the weather and must wear long pants, socks and shoes-no sandals.
9. Sunscreen and insect repellent are suggested. A cap is always advisable.
10. Alcoholic beverages and controlled substances are prohibited.
11. Firearms, Fireworks and concealed handguns are prohibited on CATRON Camp and Retreat Center property.
12. Pets are prohibited.
13. Use of non-passenger or recreational vehicles, such as mopeds and all terrain vehicles, is prohibited.
14. Smoking is not permitted anywhere at CATRON.
15. **Adult in Charge must collect Signed Health Information Form # 1 and Activity permission slips for Youth Participants. The Form will be mailed with confirmation. The CATRON Staff may ask to review this information.**
16. **Adult in Charge must collect Signed Health Information Form #1,that will be mailed with confirmation, for Adult participants. The CATRON Staff may ask to review this information.**
