

OPEN DOOR AWARD NOMINATION FORM (Nomination)

Be sure that all information is complete and typed or legibly printed using black ink. If more space is needed, you may attach one additional sheet of information. Submit the completed form to the **Service Unit Manager**. Allow 2 months for processing.

The Service Team will make its decision based on what you write about this individual, so **assume that all they know about this individual is the information you have given them**. It is important that what you include clearly supports the stated criteria for selection!

Description: Recognizes individuals or organizations who support the Girl Scout Movement by "opening their door" to further the purpose of Girl Scouting.

Nomination and Approval Procedures

Someone submits a completed **Nomination Form**. The **Service Unit Team** reviews the nominations. The Service Unit Manager orders Certificate from the Girl Scout Resource Center.

Criteria for Selection

1. Individual or organization. Do not have to be registered members of Girl Scouting.
2. Honors the donation of expertise, funding, facilities, meeting rooms or other space for Girl Scout functions at the troop/group or service unit levels.
3. The expertise, funding, or space/facility was provided on either an ongoing basis or for special events.

The Award

A certificate suitable for framing and is awarded at an appropriate Service Unit Meeting/Event.
